## USE PROCEDURES

1. Charge the toilet holding tank with clean clear water, as instructed in the aircraft manual.
2. Use one (1) HONEY BEE™ Deodorant Pak 44 per 20 L (5 gallons) of water, initially charged into the aircraft toilet holding tank.
3. Place required deodorant packs into the toilet bowl. Flush several times to dissolve.

Example: If the holding tank is initially charged with 40 L (10 gallons) of water, use two (2) deodorant packs.
